This two week, all day, intensive, volunteer program, will allow young people an opportunity to be exposed to the joys of canvassing in fulfilling the great gospel commission, right here in Toronto, Ontario.

During the program, students will receive training, books and relevant material to be distributed, vegetarian meals and lodging. Twelve applicants will be selected by the ECYC evangelism committee and notified by May 31, 2010. Upon completion of the program, the missionaries will be invited to participate in our annual Eastern Canada Youth conference event, held August 18, 2010 – August 22, 2010.
